

COOKIE POLICY – Extended version

What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files. When users visit websites these are sent to their terminals, where they are stored and then retransmitted to the same websites the next time users visit them. However, third-party cookies are created and placed by websites other than the website the user is visiting. This is because on each website there may be features (images, maps, sounds, specific links to webpages from other domains, etc.) that reside on servers other than the one visited. Cookies are used for different purposes: performing computer authentication, monitoring sessions, storing information on specific configurations regarding users access on the server, storing preferences, etc.. Below is all the information regarding the cookies installed on this website, and the essential information on how to manage your preferences regarding them.

Examples of other applications

Local storage

It is an application used to improve browsing, which does not collect data on the preferences expressed by the user (e.g. it stores a code that identifies the user's session after login, to avoid the user having to re-enter username and password on each profile page when accessing restricted areas).

Tracking pixel

"Tracking code" or "monitoring code", is a snippet of code that is released by some systems with the aim of being employed in others websites to gather some of the user's data during their browsing session or when opening emails, in a manner totally transparent to the user themselves. The type of data gathered varies considerably, such as the day and time, the geo-location, the type of device used for browsing. Other more complex tracking pixels monitor the money spent on a purchase and other useful information for the marketing departments of the companies that use them.

Plugins

It is software that interacts with another software to enhance or expand its functionality. The most commonly used plugins are those used in social networking sites, which allow, for example with just one click of a button, the user to follow a page or social profile, express whether they liked a certain web content and to share it on their social media profile, etc.

Widgets

It is a graphical user interface applications, which allow a programme to be more user-friendly. The most commonly used widgets are those used by social networking sites, allowing users to easily open up social media in a separate browser window.

These services make it possible to interact with social networking sites or other external platforms, directly from the pages of a website. The interactions and information that may be gathered by the website is subject to the privacy settings of the website that created the aforementioned tool.
